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What is Your Diagnosis

A 4 month-old, female, mixed breed dog was bit by a car days ago. On palpation, the animal showed the symptom of pain when pressing on the right shoulder area. Crepitation was not detected along the corresponding humerus.



Lateral Fig.1 ventrodorsal Fig.2 projections of right forelimb were taken. Give you diagnosis and turn to page 155

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Radiographic diagnosis

Luxation of the right scapula-humeral joint.

Radiographic findings and Comments

Luxation of the right shoulder joint was evident on both lateral and ventrodorsal projections.

Healing was unevenful 7 days after reduction and immobilization which were accomplished under general anesthesia.
